






However, when it rains, it is not possible to find a covered place to have lunch, so the students have to take refuge under the eaves of shops and other facilities. Product Overview

It has been 79 years since the atomic bombing in Hiroshima Prefecture. Participants in this program will learn about the tragedy of war in the past, with the guidance of a Peace Guide. Through dialogue, you will be encouraged to think about what a "peaceful society" and a "sustainable society" could be like in the future. This is an interactive program in which young people from Hiroshima consistently facilitate programs such as (1) serving as guides in Peace Park and (2) holding peace workshops. The development of programs with a focus on improving "empathy" helps participants acquire the ability to make an issue feel more personal to them, which is often cited as a challenge in peace education.

Recommended Points

- ☆ Participants engage in independent learning through peace education, with an emphasis on opportunities for output that focuses on dialogue (with buddies, other participants, and oneself) rather than just listening to a presentation.
- ☆ Through this program, participants are encouraged to think about what a sustainable society is and to consider their own actions (how they live their life).
- ☆ Mechanisms will be provided to help participants enhance their "empathy."
- ☆ Specific details of the program can be arranged as requested by the school and/or participants.
- ☆ This program is led by young people who provide content that is easy for participants to relate to and empathize with.

- ① Tour of Peace Memorial Park**
Participants will be guided around the monuments in Peace Memorial Park. Your guide will describe the lives of the people of the former Nakajima district, which was once one of Hiroshima's most bustling shopping areas, as well as the history and thoughts of the people of Hiroshima. While walking through the park, you will feel the power of this place, and be encouraged to reexamine yourself, and the "ordinary everyday life" that you lead now, through the lens of "peace."
- ② Peace Workshop**
Under the facilitation of Peace Buddies, discussions will be held based on a specific theme, and with a focus on the present and future. (Examples of themes: peace culture, global human resources, SDGs, etc.) Peace Buddies who have studied facilitation will encourage the students to speak out and provide support for them to continue learning on their own initiative.

The company's factory in Fuchu, which was established as a rubber manufacturer, has a history of around 80 years. It also has a shop/cafe where you can take a break and maybe do a little shopping.

Fuchu miso (fermented soybean paste) is said to have a 400-year tradition. The white miso, in particular, was praised by various feudal lords during the Edo period, and the phrase "Don't miss the miso in Fuchu" spread throughout Japan. It has been selected as a "100-year food." Souvenirs can be purchased here.
